- 5. What caused the grumbling by the first workers?
- 6. What does the second part of the story (v8-15) teach about the master's character?
- 7. This story is part of Jesus' response to Peter's question. In the kingdom of heaven, who do you think the first workers and last workers represent?
- 8. How does this story help us understand the reversal of first and last (19:30, 20:16)?
- 9. What does this passage encourage us to remember about God?
- 10. How might this passage be helpful to someone who is weighing the cost of following Jesus?
- **11.** Are you ever tempted to compare yourself with others and grumble that God is being unfair? How do Jesus' words speak to you?
