What is Tuesday Night Training?

Training is an important part of what we do at St. Mary's Cathedral. Each term we run a series of different training courses, both theological and in ministry skills, to better equip ourselves to live as Christians, and to share in Gospel-centered ministry.

All courses start at 8pm on a Tuesday evening, and are held at the cathedral itself. There is a catered dinner available for those who pre-book it, at a contribution of RM10/week and served from 7:15pm onwards. We run a few different courses at the same time, that way there's something for everyone.

Below is a key to help you decide which course would be most suitable for you. Please speak to a member of the pastoral team if you would like any further guidance.

- ◆◇◇◇◇ Suitable for Christians no matter how much or little they already know

- ◆◆◆◆◇ Suitable for Christians in or training for vocational ministry
